

PIONEER VOLLEYBALL RULES – 2021
ABSOLUTELY NO CARRY IN'S OF BEVERAGES OR FOOD ALLOWED

1. Team rosters must be turned in before the start of 1st game.

- A. A MAXIMUM of **12 players** per roster
 - B. No player is allowed to play at pioneer bowl unless he/she has signed an official team roster release form.
 - C. Maximum players on court 6; minimum 2.
 - D. No player's name shall be on more than 1 roster from the same league night.
 - E. Any team using an ineligible player shall forfeit the game.
 - F. Any player must be on the roster and play a minimum of 2 matches to be eligible to play in the year end tournament
 - G. Players must be at least 17 yrs of age, players under the age of 18 (2 maximum), must have parent sign waiver form.
2. Team must rotate before first serve. Players rotating into middle back if playing with more than 6.
3. Rope lines are the boundary lines. Any ball landing on or within the court line will be considered a fairly hit ball.
4. There will be no center mid-court rope boundary line, however any player making obvious contact with an opposing player across the imaginary mid-court line will be called, under the net.
5. Net serves are good. Serve cannot be blocked or attacked over the height of the net.
6. 10 minute firm grace period will be allowed per game. After 10 minutes 1st match forfeited, 10 minutes later 2nd match forfeited and 10 minutes after that the 3rd match forfeited.
7. Only 2 minute breaks will be allowed between matches.
8. All games will be played rally scoring (point will be awarded against any team losing the ball.) **Up to 21 points must be won by 2 points.** 25 point maximum with no 2 point difference.
9. RAINOUTS are not called until 4:30 pm. Rain delays (15 minutes) or when to stop the game will be up to the referee's discretion. Any incomplete game will be restarted (not complete match).
10. Captains must sign/initial the roster before the match & score sheet after the match is complete.
11. Head to head results and/or division records will be used for tie breakers in final standings. If standings are still tied, points scored will be used for the second tie-breaker.
12. All participants must adhere to the rules listed under Pioneer Bowl Provisions governing sports. (No beverages on the field area, no smoking while participating, no swearing or abusive language).

* * * * * COED RULES * * * * *

1. Positioning is up to each team, however once a game begins rotation must remain the same.
2. A team cannot have more men than women on the court at any time.
3. Substitutions can only be made as man for man, and woman for woman. Substitutions can only be made into the middle back.
4. Men or women can come up from the back row to assist a block. They may not attack the ball in the front row when they are considered a back row player.
5. Hitting; if the ball is not directly returned to an opponent on the first hit by a man, a woman must play the ball before it can be returned as the second or third hit.
6. All other volleyball rules will be followed as stated above in the pioneer volleyball game rules.
